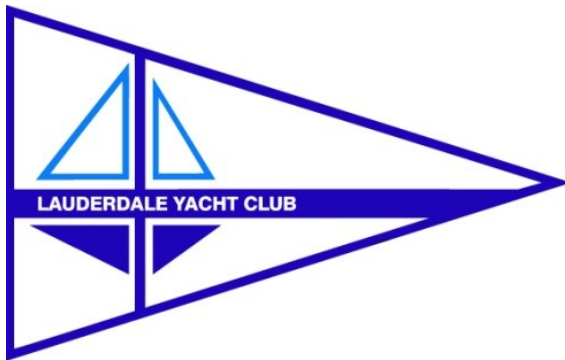

The Organising Authority (AO) is the Lauderdale Yacht Club Inc., Hobart (LYC) in conjunction with the Tasmanian Paper Tiger Catamaran Association Inc. (TPTCA) Frederick Henry Bay, Hobart, Tasmania, Australia.

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in ISAF 2009-2012 *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2. The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) will apply.
- 1.3. The rules of the Paper Tiger Catamaran Class will apply.
- 1.4. Racing rules will be changed as follows:

Rule 28.1 (Sailing the Course);
Rule 35 (Time Limit and Scores);
Rules 44.1 & 44.2 (Penalties);
Rule 60.1(a) (Protesting);
Rules 61.3 and 62.2 (Protest Time Limits);
Rule 66 (Reopening a Hearing);
Rule A4.1 (Scoring).
The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

2. Advertising

- 2.1. The regatta is designated in accordance with ISAF Advertising Code, Regulation 20.3.
- 2.2. The organising authority may require competing boats to carry event sponsor advertising on the hull.

3. Eligibility and Entry

- 3.1. The regatta is open to all boats of the Paper Tiger Catamaran Class.
- 3.2. Competitors must be financial members of their respective state class association.
- 3.3. Boats shall retain the same skipper for all races in the series.
- 3.4. The closing date for entries is the 3rd December 2010, using the attached Entry Form accompanied by the required fee (see below) and mailing it to Michael Boyle, 6 Eden Place Howrah, TAS, 7018 or e-mail mickspot@yahoo.com.au. The required fee may also be submitted electronically (see Entry Form for details).
- 3.5. Late entries, accompanied the additional late entry fee (see below), may be accepted at the above addresses, at the Organising Authority's discretion.

- 4.1. Required Entry Fee for Seniors (18 or over on 31/12/10): \$180
- 4.2. Required Entry Fee for Juniors (under 18 on 31/12/10): \$100
- 4.3. Late Entry Fee: \$20

- 5.4. No race shall start after 1430hrs on 10/01/2011.

6. Measurements

- 6.1. Competitors shall submit a copy of their valid measurement certificate with their entry and, in addition, shall present their boat during the prescribed measurement period where the following measurement checks will be taken: boat weight, mast dimensions, and sail dimensions.

7. Sailing Instructions

- 7.1. The sailing instructions will be available at registration. They may also be published in advance on the event web site www.papertiger2011.catsailor.org

8. Venue

- 8.1. The races will be held on Frederick Henry Bay, Hobart, in the vicinity of Lauderdale Yacht Club (LYC), as described in the sailing instructions. Directions to the venue will be issued upon receipt of entry, and published in advance on the event web site www.papertiger2011.catsailor.org

9. The Courses

- 9.1. The diagrams in Attachment 1 show the courses, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left. The approximate length of the first leg of the course will be 1.0 nautical mile for Course 1 and 0.5 nautical miles for Course 2.

10. Penalty System

- 10.1. Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only One Turn Penalty, including one tack and one gybe is required.
- 10.2. Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

11. Scoring

- 11.1. Four races shall be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.2. Races to be counted towards series score:
- 11.2.1. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.2.2. When from five to seven races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score, except when prohibited in RRS 89.3(b).
- 11.2.3. When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores, except when prohibited in RRS 89.3(b).

12. Radio Communication

- 12.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

13. Prizes

- 13.1. Trophies and/or prizes may be awarded in the following divisions, depending on the number of entries in each (others may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Committee):
- 13.1.1. Overall Championship.
 - 13.1.2. Junior Championship (under 18 as at 31/12/2010)
 - 13.1.3. 'B' Grade (as per the National Ranking system)
 - 13.1.4. 'C' Grade (as per the National Ranking system)
 - 13.1.5. Women's Division
 - 13.1.6. Veteran's Division (50 or over as at 31/12/2010)
 - 13.1.7. Super Veteran's Division (60 or over as at 31/12/2010)
 - 13.1.8. Top Ten
 - 13.1.9. Race winners
 - 13.1.10. Rookie of the year

14. Disclaimer of Liability

- 14.1. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, decision to race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15. Insurance

- 15.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party public liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent.

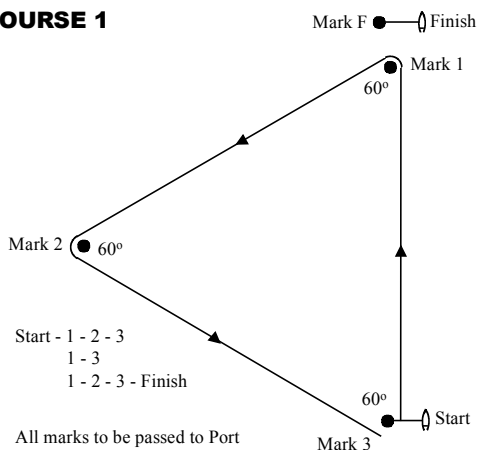
